

2020 Housing Assistance Opportunity - City of Greenfield

The City of Greenfield is exploring a housing program that can benefit homeowners in Greenfield by providing a grant to repair house exteriors. The program is described below.

Exterior Improvements Program – This program provides forgivable loans to homeowners who have modest incomes and need to fix up the outside of their homes. Work might include new siding, windows, doors, roof, foundation, etc. This program is designed to modernize the exteriors of homes for people that cannot afford to do so without the assistance. Generally, if your household earns less than \$40,000 per year for a smaller family and \$60,000 for a larger family, you **may** qualify.

There is no cost to apply and the program may only cost you about \$17 to participate in the program **if** the grant is awarded. Up to about \$30,000 in repairs are possible from the grant.

Any homeowner in Greenfield can apply for this program. We will review this application and contact you if you appear eligible for the next steps in the process.
